Last hearing held on 28.07.2023 and the next date of hearing is to be notified. Because of stay granted by AP High Court, Regulation of access is not being implemented by NLDC/RLDCs.
2	Odisha Power Generation Corporation Ltd	9.74	213 Days	LTA relinquished by OPGCL w.e.f 13.12.2018. OPGCL is evacuating its power through intrastate transmission system of Odisha and presently, there is no existing LTA or MTOA with ISTS, hence, no LTA/MTOA/STOA regulation could be implemented by NLDC/RLDCs. Further, in an Appeal No.16 of 2020 filed by OPGCL against the levy of transmission charges for mismatch period, Hon'ble APTEL restrained CTU from encashing the Bank Guarantee submitted by OPGCL until disposal of the Appeal No. 322 of 2019. Matter is being pursued.
